




How Employers are Addressing the Skills Gap

Cross-Border Teams Bridging Talent Gaps


As hiring demand continues despite growing talent scarcity, 57% of employers are willing to hire internationally, although 15% are not planning to accelerate this.

A Holistic Talent Strategy


